

APPLICATION FOR SKILLS FOR A SUCCESSFUL FUTURE PROGRAMME



Are you a youth aged between 15 and 25, who can't afford to pay and/or has no family members to help pay for your vocational studies?

The Schooling for Life Foundation offers an intensive three pillar schooling programme consisting of:

- Scholarships for the vocational education of a student's choice.
- Extra-curricular skills training at a Schooling for Life training centre.
- Personal guidance by a professional guidance counsellor to help with your studies and personal development.

Student criteria:

- You must have passed secondary education (at WASCE level, with credit in English and Math, and a credit in a subject required for your study of choice).
- You are home based in Freetown.
- You are not able to pay for your own tertiary education (or through network).
- You need to put in the necessary time and commitment (100% attendance required in all three pillars above).
- You must be willing to learn new information and commit to implementing this information into your daily life (Walk the walk).
- You should have a strong ambition as to what you wish to accomplish in life, and a clear idea about what you want to be professionally is an absolute must.
- Students awaiting WASCE results are only considered if results are out before the SfL recruitment processes commences.

Do you recognise yourself in these requirements?

Are you willing to put in the effort and time to improve yourself and your chances in the job market? If so, then apply by:

- Writing a motivational letter in your own handwriting (NOT TYPED) explaining your motivation to change your life and your ambitions, and what you have already done to try to achieve this.
- Writing a short CV (no more than 2 pages) that contains your schooling experience and possible work experience.
- Providing two letters of recommendation: One from your last attended school, one from a friend or family member.
- Providing a copy of your national Identification/Voter ID card/ birth certificate.
- Copy of your school certificate(s). WASCE results.
- A passport picture.

Schooling for Life only sponsors students who wish to start and complete a vocational diploma course (NO UNIVERSITY).
